aboard and learn more about? Would it make you feel a bit proud to know you helped a fellow boater be safer on the water? What if you could teach someone where to place the boat registration number on any boat? How many fire extinguishers are required on a boat? What must be in the green to be safe? Does lighting and whether it is working make any difference? Are there enough life vests on your boat and do they meet Coast Guard standards?


